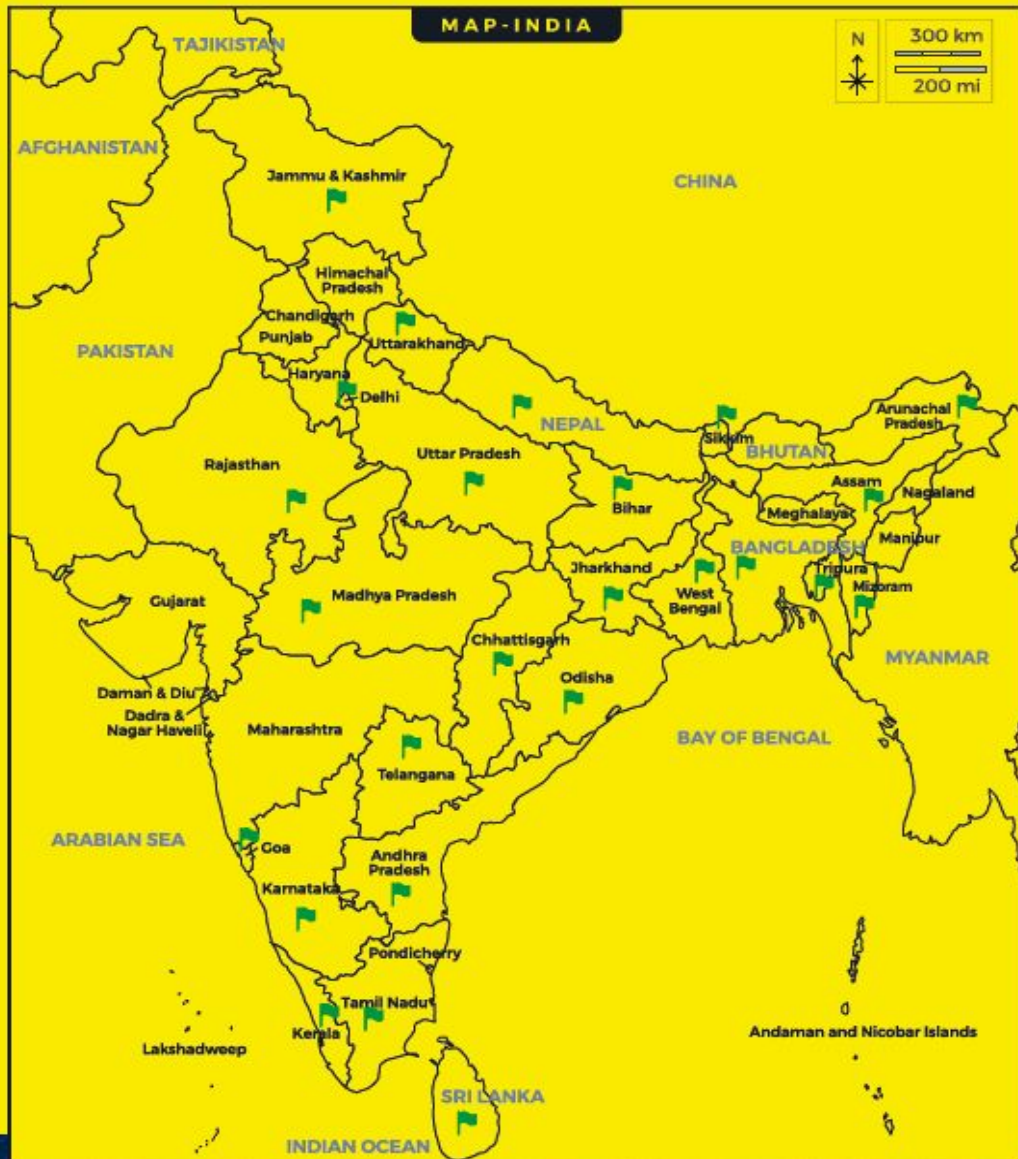
Context

South Asia faced a large burden of untreated faecal waste and used water entering the environment, causing public and environmental risks.

Citywide Sanitation is a means to achieve the outcome of safely managed sanitation as per SDG 6.3.

1. Online certificate course in City Wide Inclusive Sanitation (CWIS)
2. Sanitours for leadership development in CWIS
