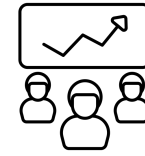
Financial Sustainability

- Integrating cost for sanitation in property tax
- Leveraging multiple sources of finance; 15th FC, SBM 2.0, AMRUT
- State investment plans for phase-wise FSM roll-out
- Private sector participation and PPP models for FSSM



Strengthening Service Delivery

- Monitoring tools to track quality desludging services (GPS Monitoring, Sanitab/ Sanitrack)
- Clustering of ULBs to utilize single FSTP infrastructure
- Innovative technology and business models



Institutional Capacity Building

- Establishing sanitation Support Cells in each ULB
- Training for elected councilors and ULB officials for FSSM adoption at scale
- Establishing guidelines and regulations to monitor FSSM



Community Engagement

- Contracting women and trans-SHGs for FSTP O&M
- Establishing community-led decision making platforms



Sanitation Worker Safety

- Establishing mandates for PPE usage and availability
- Launching state schemes for san-worker welfare insurance remittances
- Mechanization options



Disseminating knowledge and learnings from India to South Asia by fostering a **regional collaboration** towards **cross learning and sharing**

Knowledge Dissemination



Workshops and convenings

Curate **workshops, convenings, working groups** at a South Asia level, aggregate knowledge and share **learnings, case stories, and challenges** on CWIS



South to South Exposure Visits

Curate **exposure visits** that enable stakeholders to learn from and share implementation approaches based on the gaps and thematic area of focus



Institutional Capacity Building

Advisory and mentorship support towards **strengthening the Communities of Practice** to scale CWIS



Codifying Learnings & Best Practices

Support local partners towards curating **knowledge products / media narratives** to build thought leadership and allow replication

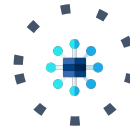

Way Forward for the NFSSM Alliance to scale CWIS in India



City-Wide Inclusive Sanitation (CWIS)

- **Cross-cutting Theme:** City-wide inclusive sanitation which aims to provide access to safe sanitation facilities for all to be a cross cutting theme for all Alliance's activities
- **Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) and Climate Change:** The Alliance to amplify their framework on DRR and link it to building disaster and climate resilient cities



Policy Recommendations Informing National Priorities

- **Policy Support:** Leverage the technical expertise of Alliance partners to develop policy recommendations to inform government priorities
- **Government Engagement:** the NFSSM Alliance to work closely with key Ministries and Departments to continue prioritizing inclusive sanitation in India

- **Building FSSM Capacity and Ecosystem Strengthening:** Capacity Building Workshops for FSSM Planning and Adoption with state and city officials
